## **GUIDELINES FOR THE ELECTION OF ORDINARY MEMBERS**

### **1. ORDINARY MEMBERS**

Individuals applying for Ordinary Membership should normally be actively engaged in toxicological or experimental pathology and their experience and training must be acceptable to Council.

Also; individuals who are recognised by Council to have an active interest in, or, are actively supporting toxicological and experimental pathology, and whose experience and training are acceptable to Council, may apply for Ordinary Membership of the Society.

Applications when submitted should include a curriculum vitae and any other relevant supporting material together with supporting letters from two Members of the Society.

Ordinary Members shall have all the privileges of Membership, including the right to vote and hold office, and they shall pay an annual fee.

### **2. MEMBERSHIP**

Election to membership shall be by the Council, applications for membership will usually be considered at the next available Council Meeting and applicants will be notified by the Honorary Secretary of the Council's decision within 4 weeks of the date of that meeting.

The Council shall have the right for good and sufficient reason to reject an application for membership.

The BSTP is registered with the UK Information Commissioners Office (ICO) - Data Protection Act and in addition to its UK responsibilities, the ICO has an international role including co-operation with similar organisations in the rest of Europe and with the European Commission. Your details will be added to

our mailing list and you will automatically receive future information when it becomes available. Your details will not be passed on to any other organisation without written permission from yourself.

### **3. TOXICOLOGIC PATHOLOGY**

The official journal of the BSTP is **Toxicologic Pathology** - <http://tpx.sagepub.com/>. As a subscriber, you will receive 8 issues a year and you will be issued with a membership number and will be able to view and search issues back to 1999.

For those who want to subscribe to the journal through the BSTP, there are two methods of subscription: **Print and online** access which will cost £55 in addition to the membership fee i.e. £105 or you can subscribe to the journal with **online access only** at a cost of £35 in addition to the membership fee i.e. £85. Existing STP members will receive their copy though the STP as usual.

To receive **Toxicologic Pathology** you need to tick the relevant box on the membership application form so that the subscription fee due can be adjusted accordingly. Please note that subscription will be valid for 1 year and no refunds are available if you cancel midterm.

Please note that, if you opt to receive **Toxicologic Pathology**, your contact details will be passed to the STP who will pass them to the publishers of the journal. Details of each issue will be sent to you direct from the publishers. Your positive response will indicate your permission for the Secretariat to release your contact details to these third parties.
