

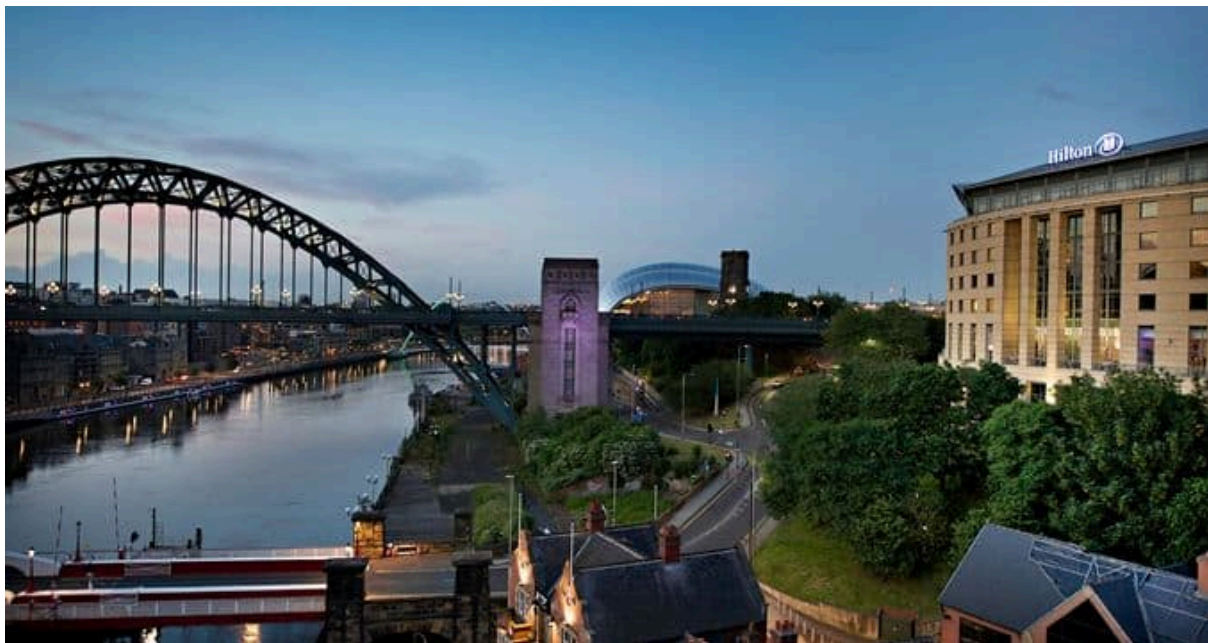

## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Abstracts should be submitted using the Online system
- Abstracts should be no more than 500 words in total, to include references.
- Abstracts will be printed in black and white.

### **ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM**

Deadline for submission is **midnight on Sunday 13th October 2019**

**Policy for scientific abstract selection for the joint British Society of Toxicological Pathology (BSTP) and British Toxicology Society (BTS) Congress**

#### ABSTRACT SELECTION PROCESS

- All abstracts submitted through the formal abstract submission process and by the deadline will be considered by the abstract review team.
- The abstract editors will make recommendations for selected and rejected abstracts following the criteria below.
- The congress abstract committee will inform all applicants of the outcome of their abstract submission.

#### GENERAL ABSTRACT SELECTION CRITERIA

**Abstracts will be rejected if they:**

- Contain material construed as being obscene, defamatory, libellous, unlawful or any way legally actionable,
- Are advertisements, for example descriptions of commercial services or products,
- Contain work lacking appropriate ethical approval or in breach of legal requirements,

**In the context of the congress, abstracts will also be rejected if they:**

- Do not contain data deemed relevant to the interests of either the BSTP or BTS membership,
- Are poorly structured and do not provide a clear rationale and outcome for the study

#### ORAL COMMUNICATION ABSTRACT SELECTION CRITERIA

- Abstracts must meet all the general abstract selection criteria
- The submitting author must have selected they are willing to give an oral communication
- The subject matter is deemed to be of interest or impact to the membership of BSTP and BTS
- Due to the limit on number of oral communications opportunities, not all abstracts that meet the criteria can be selected. Those not selected would be invited to present a poster communication at the congress.

Due to the limit on oral communications not all abstracts that meet the criteria can be selected. Abstracts will be selected on the basis of scientific merit and interest. Those not selected will be invited to give a poster communication at the congress.
