Preliminary Programme

Thursday 26th October 2017

An exciting programme is being developed which will be of interest to toxicologists, pathologists and other scientists interested in inhalation toxicology and respiratory delivery of drugs.

Following registration and an introduction from the AIT, the morning session will focus on inhaled biologics. This session will also include a “Technology on the Pitch” 2 minute overview from each of the exhibitors.

After lunch the start of the afternoon session will remain focussed on inhaled biologics (with presentation of some case studies) followed by talks on aerosol characterisation and measurements.

During lunchtime, the mid morning and mid afternoon breaks there will be time to tour the poster presentations and trade exhibition stands.


Following the first days conference presentations, a welcome reception and conference dinner will be held in the beautiful area of Tivoli. Guests and delegates are requested to arrive from 19:00 hours onwards for the welcome reception with the dinner starting at 20:00.

Friday 27th October 2017

Lectures on the second day of the meeting will include issues arising when using different inhaled formulations, an introduction to Minipigs as a model for inhalation and a CRACKIT Initiative update. Again there will be time to tour the poster presentations and trade exhibition stands during the scheduled breaks in the day.

The second day will include the Annual General Meeting of the AIT (just prior to lunch).

All scientific topics relating to inhalation involving new technologies, rodent and/or non rodent species used in inhalation toxicology, pathology, pharmacology, discovery and clinical pathology are welcome. If you are interested in presenting a poster please contact the AIT. You will also need to submit an abstract submission (approximately 200 words) by 1st September 2017 at the latest.

You can of course just bring your poster with you to the meeting and it will be displayed if there are unallocated spaces remaining.

Please do encourage your colleagues to attend; this meeting offers an ideal opportunity for “first time” presenters to exhibit a poster or undertake a case presentation.

You can book online or call them (telephone number above) and quote the **AIT reference number 1573433**. The conference rate is DKK 1595/night for Wednesday and Thursday nights. Forty rooms are reserved for the AIT conference and if not taken up will be released for general booking from 25th September 2017.

Booking online may result in a better rate, especially if you're staying more than those two nights.

The Tivoli hotel has all of the latest state-of-the-art amenities and offers everything from indoor parking, fitness centre and swimming pool, an outdoor playground and free-of-charge WiFi. There are three restaurants at the hotel; Tivoli Brasserie, Sticks'n'Sushi Skybar and MASH Penthouse.

Transport

From Copenhagen Airport

You can take the train direct from Copenhagen Airport Terminal 3 on track 2 to Copenhagen. Get off at Copenhagen Central Station and walk to the hotel, which is within 8-10 minutes walking distance.

You can also get a train on tracks 11 and 12 at Central Station that will take you to Dybbølsbro Station. Tickets from the airport to Copenhagen Central Station are also valid on the bus, metro and S-train.

Taking a taxi from the airport will cost approx. DKK 280. All taxis are metered and accept all major international credit cards.

From the Oslo boat

Take the S-train from Østerport Station and get off at Dybbølsbro Station. The hotel is located 5 minutes walk from the station.

From Vesterport Station and Copenhagen Central Station you can take bus 34 that stops right across the street from the hotel (Bus stop – Tivoli Hotel (Kalvebod Brygge)).

Driving

If you come from the highway E20 towards Copenhagen

- Take exit 20 - Copenhagen C towards O2 continue 2.5 km
- Keep left and follow Sjællandsbroen approx. 1km
- Continue along Sydhavnsgade 500m (follow signs towards Copenhagen C)
- Keep right and follow Scandiagade approx. 350 meters
- Continue along Vasbygade/O2 approx.1.5 km

- Continue onto Kalvebod Brygge approx. 300 meters
- Turn left onto Arni Magnussons Gade
- Follow the road around the Tivoli Hotel & Congress Center
- Turn right onto Carsten Niebuhrs Gade and turn right after you passed by hotel Wake Up to the underground parking at the Tivoli Hotel & Congress Center (Tivoli hotel share parking with Hotel WakeUp). There is direct access to the Tivoli hotel from the underground parking area.

Please note that if you use an older GPS it may not find Arni Magnussons Gade 2, search for Carsten Niebuhrs Gade 11 instead.

If you come from Hillerød Highway direction Copenhagen

- Continue straight ahead of Hareskovvej approx. 2 km
- Continue straight ahead of Borups Avenue approx. 2.5 km
- Continue straight ahead over Bispeengbuen approx. 500m
- Continue straight ahead of Ågade approx. 500 meters
- Continue straight ahead of Åboulevard approx. 500 meters
- Continue straight ahead of Gyldenløvesgade approx. 500 meters
- Continue straight ahead of H.C. Andersens Boulevard approx. 1km
- Turn right onto Tietgensgade (just after Tivoli) approx. 300 meters
- Turn left onto Bernstorffsgade approx. 200 meters
- Turn left onto Carsten Niebuhrs Gade approx. 200 meters
- Turn left on Kristian Erslevs Gade (just before Hotel WakeUp) and drive into the underground parking at the Tivoli Hotel & Congress Center. There is direct access to the hotel from the parking area.

Parking

In cooperation with Wakeup Copenhagen, Tivoli Hotel offers a video-monitored car park for all hotel guests. The car park is located between the two hotels and has direct access to Tivoli Hotel through the basement.

All you have to do is draw a ticket upon arrival and pay at departure by credit card in the car park.

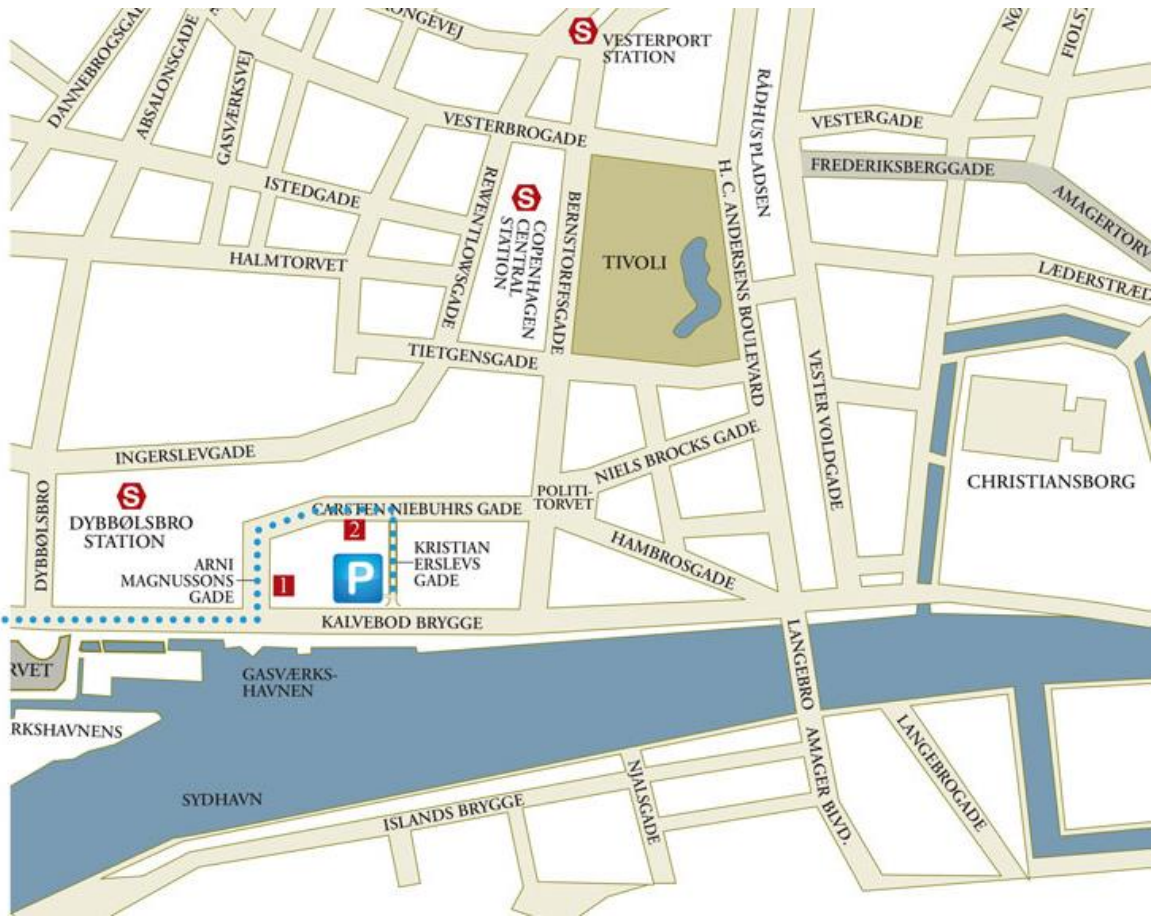
The hotel cannot guarantee availability. Furthermore, it is not possible to book a parking space in advance.

For all electric car drivers, the hotel has installed chargers on all levels of the car park. On the ground floor, there is a Pod Point charger with three different standard plugs, whereas there is a Pod Point charging station on all other levels.
