The BSTP is offering a number of bursaries of up to £500 for this meeting to help towards the cost of registration and travel. In addition, successful candidates will receive a year's free membership of the BSTP worth £50.

Applicants must be stipendiary students studying a relevant subject, including veterinary pathology residents, or students with a relevant PhD project.

Applications will be assessed by the BSTP Council on merit. Priority will be given to candidates who have submitted poster abstracts to the meeting.

Criteria for application:

1. The applicant must submit a brief description of the relevance of the meeting to their training or career needs and provide the following information:
 - a. A completed BSTP membership application form including:
 - i. Brief CV.
 - ii. A letter of recommendation from their supervisor (in lieu of recommendation from BSTP members if unavailable).
 - b. Details of all alternative funding that they will receive for the meeting.
 - c. Up to 3 suggestions for future educational activities/topics that would be helpful to their training in mouse pathology.
 - d. If applicable their poster abstract.

2. Following the meeting and prior to receipt of the bursary funds the successful applicants must submit:
 - a. A short article (approx 500 words) describing either their own research or how the meeting will help their research or career which will be published on the BSTP Website (this will appear in the members-only section of the website).
 - b. Receipts for expenses incurred for the meeting (travel/registration).
