As part of our commitment to support education in veterinary pathology, the BSVP is pleased to offer TWO travel bursaries for veterinary pathology trainees who wish to attend the BSVP Gastrointestinal Pathology Meeting 2019. Each bursary is worth £200 and includes free registration. All bursary applicants should submit a 10-minute PowerPoint presentation detailing the presentation, diagnosis and outcome of a gastrointestinal pathology case. Cases from all species are welcome.

The requirements for the travel bursary are as follows:

1. The candidates should be preparing for a pathology board examination (as signed off by their sponsor).
2. The candidates can be of any nationality and work in any country.
3. The candidates shall not have received a BSVP award in the last 2 years.
4. The successful candidates will receive free annual membership.
5. The successful candidates will present their gastrointestinal pathology case at the BSVP 2019 Companion Animal Meeting (10-minute presentation).
6. The case presentation must be ethically acceptable.
