The journal has recently introduced a new category of mini review that is in addition to the review, invited review and original article categories. These succinct manuscripts should have the same structure as full-length original review articles, but in much shorter form, and the section headings will be used only for the abstract, acknowledgements, and references.

Mini reviews may describe any topic relevant to the practice of toxicologic pathology that does not warrant a full-length paper. Mini reviews are summaries of recent insights or advances in areas within the scope of the journal and are usually prepared by experts in a particular specialty area. Authors should provide a balanced overview of the field and not focus on their own work or the work of close colleagues.

Mini Reviews should not exceed 12 double-spaced, typed pages. In addition to the text, there may be 1-2 figures and 1-2 tables. Abstracts should not exceed 150 words, and the number of citations should be limited to 15.
