● **JEJU Island in June**

Jeju Island located off the southernmost coast of South Korea is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Asia, as the island is rich in natural tourist attributes such as UNESCO World Heritage Sites (designated for Jeju Volcanic Island and Lava Tubes in 2007), Global Geoparks Network (2010), Biosphere Reserve (2002), and New Seven Wonders of Nature (2012). The climate of Jeju is typically characterized by distinct four seasons, with mild winter, and average weather patterns in June are ideal for a convention; average June temperature during the seasonal transition from spring to summer is 21 degrees Celsius. Clear spring water from volcanically formed rock beds (even tap water is pure and potable) and wind breezes from the ocean side refresh and relax you after a hard day of congress technical program. The whole island of Jeju is a natural ecology park that includes "Gotjawal", unique plant habitat in Jeju vernacular and botanically diverse Halla mountainsides, and observing a variety of seaweeds and marine animals along the island's extraordinarily scenic coastline. For nature lovers' fun and exercise, one can also trek along "Olle" courses and climb "Oreums", volcanically formed cinder-cones scattered around the island.
