# Guidance for civil society representatives on EMA's corporate website relaunch: What you need to know and what you need to do

### Outdated links to pre-September 2018 website discontinued

EMA's relaunched website will no longer support links that refer to the version of the website from before September 2018. This means all links to the EMA's website starting with 'http:' (as in -http://www.ema.europa.eu/) will stop working. Therefore, we advise to update these outdated links before 5 December 2023.

### How to identify which links to update

- Links to our homepage starting with "<a href="http://" instead of https://" instead of https://" instead of https://www.ema.europa.eu/ema</a>
- Links to web pages starting with <a href="http://">http://</a>, containing "index.jsp?" in the URL as highlighted in the following example: <a href="http://www.ema.europa.eu/ema/index.jsp?">http://www.ema.europa.eu/ema/index.jsp?</a>
- Links to documents starting with "http://" with a file name starting with "WC5" as highlighted in following example:
  <a href="http://www.ema.europa.eu/docs/en\_EN/document\_library/EPAR">http://www.ema.europa.eu/docs/en\_EN/document\_library/EPAR</a> <a href="Product\_Information/human/000603/WC5">Product\_Information/human/000603/WC5</a> 00044686.pdf

### How to replace these links

 Replace the outdated link with the matching page or document on our relaunched website - links to web pages or documents should start with <a href="https://www.ema.europa.eu">https://www.ema.europa.eu</a>

While replacing old links, make sure you apply the following best practice in terms of titles:

- Provide meaningful titles to pages replace a page with the following outdated URL structure like <a href="http://www.ema.europa.eu/ema/index.jsp?curl=pages/regulation/general/general\_content\_00\_1768.jsp&mid=WC0b01ac0580b18a3a">https://www.ema.europa.eu/en/human-general/general\_content\_00\_1768.jsp&mid=WC0b01ac0580b18a3a</a>
  with one containing a meaningful title like <a href="https://www.ema.europa.eu/en/human-regulatory/research-development">https://www.ema.europa.eu/en/human-regulatory/research-development</a>
- Provide meaningful titles to documents replace a document with the following outdated structure like <a href="http://www.ema.europa.eu/docs/en\_EN/document\_library/EPAR\_-">http://www.ema.europa.eu/en/documents/product-</a>
  Product Information/human/000603/WC500044686.pdf
  with one containing a meaningful title like <a href="https://www.ema.europa.eu/en/documents/product-">https://www.ema.europa.eu/en/documents/product-</a>

## New links to CHMP and CVMP opinions for new medicines and recommendations of extension of indication

Our CHMP and CVMP summary of opinion pages will have different URLs. Below are some examples for CHMP opinions whose URLs will change (same applies to veterinary pages which have an identical link format, with the only changing being '/veterinary/' instead of '/human/'):

### New links to withdrawn applications for new medicines and recommendations of extension of indication

Links to our withdrawn application pages for human and veterinary medicines will have different URLs. Below are some examples (same applies to veterinary pages which have an identical link format, with the only changing being '/veterinary/' instead of '/human/'):
